Market Insight

Cattle numbers at Dalby increased by 1,438 to a total of 6,028 head. This included 1,078 cows and 298 bulls. Export buyers attended, but not all were active. Regular feedlot and restocker buyers were operating.

Prices for light weight yearling steers going back to the paddock varied depending on quality, with well-bred cattle selling strongly. Yearling steers to feed showed similar results. Light weight yearling heifers to restockers sold for higher prices. Better quality heavy weight yearling heifers to feed lifted average prices by 10c/kg.

Heavy grown steers and bullocks were 6c/kg cheaper on average. Cow prices were steady to 5c/kg higher.

Prices:

- Light weight yearling steers to restockers: up to **594c/kg**, averaging 533c/kg.
- Yearling steers to feed (domestic): up to **556c/kg**, averaging 490–499c/kg.
- Heavy weight yearling steers to feed: averaged 491c/kg, up to **511c/kg**.
- Light weight yearling heifers to restockers: up to **458c/kg**, mostly 407–424c/kg.
- Medium weight yearling heifers to feed: averaged 402c/kg, up to **465c/kg**.
- Heavy weight yearling heifers to feed: averaged 424c/kg, up to **468c/kg**.
- Bullocks: up to **460c/kg**, averaging 434c/kg.
- Grown heifers: up to **448c/kg**.
- Medium weight 2 score cows: averaged 337c/kg, up to **347c/kg**.
- Heavy weight 3 score cows: averaged **365c/kg**.
- Best heavy cows: up to **395c/kg**, averaging 385c/kg.
- Heavy weight bulls: up to **407c/kg**.
