Market Insight

There were slightly fewer cattle this week (7,772 total), but numbers were still high. A large number of cows and heifers were sold. While export buyers were present, they were picky, and there were fewer feed and trade buyers than last week.

Prices mostly dropped across all categories, young steers (for restocking or feeding) were generally 20–28c/kg cheaper, though top-quality ones held their value. Heifers also sold for 5–24c/kg less, but high-quality animals still sold well. Cow prices continued to fall, dropping another 7–17c/kg

Price highlights:

- **Light steers:** up to **552c/kg**, averaging around 489–504c/kg
- **Steers for feed:** mostly **471–489c/kg**
- **Heifers:** varied widely depending on quality (around 265–446c/kg)
- **Heavy steers and bullocks:** around **442c/kg**
- **Cows:** 325–372c/kg, with top cows up to **390c/kg**
- **Bulls:** up to **398c/kg**

Overall:

The market was softer this week, with most prices going down, but good-quality cattle still sold strongly.
